Angel is 12 years old in primary one class. The father died when she was still young and now, she lives with her mother who struggles to cater for her needs which among others includes education. The Mother does odd around the village in order to earn a living.

Prossy is a six-year-old in Middle class, she lives with her mother who is mentally unstable, her father is a drug addict who does not provide anything for her daughter. The mother barely gets any reasonable job to earn the living.



5. **NANYUNJA BETTY**

Betty is eight years old in primary two. She has other seven siblings. The father abandoned the family and She lives with her poor mother who struggles to support a family



6. NINSIIMA ANGEL

Angel is eight-year-old in primary one at Zana Community Christian School. She stays with only her mother who has no definite job, her father abandoned them. They currently stay in an incomplete building which has no windows and doors that was given to them by a well-wisher. The mother washes clothes and sometimes collects bottles in order to earn a living.



7. TAYEBWA JOSHUA

He is a ten-year-old in primary four class at Zana Community Christian School. He lives with a guardian who takes care of him. His mother was murdered by his father who later on took his own life by taking poison when he was only 2 years old. The guardian has a small stall where she sells tomatoes and onions in order to earn a living and care of Joshua. She cannot fully support her family. So she needs help



8. MUKISA MAURICE ELIJAH

Elijah is a twelve-year-old in primary six at Zana Community Christian School. He comes from a family of six siblings and currently lives with his mother, she separated the father who completely abandoned the family. The mother has no permanent job as she washes clothes and sometimes fetches water for the people around the village in order to earn a living.



9. IZABAYO JOSHUA

Joshua is a twelve-year-old in primary five at Zana Community Christian School. He is the youngest out of the six siblings. Joshua was given by the father to somebody as he could not take care of him since he had no job, the mother lives way back in the village with his other siblings. The guardian cannot raise funds to take him through school.



10. KALEMA PRAISE ROWANAH

Praise is an eight year in primary one at Zana Community Christian School. She lives with her poor mother and grandmother. The father is completely out of the picture. They both cannot support her in her education.



11. KINTU JACKSON

Jackson is a seven-year-old in primary one at Zana Community Christian School, Jackson lives with her mother and brother. His father was imprisoned. The mother is struggling to provide for the family as she operates a small stall selling groceries such as food stuffs like tomatoes and onions to earn a living.



12. NANYONJO HOPE

Nanyonjo is an eleven-year-old in primary five class at Zana community Christian School. She lives with her mother, the dad abandoned her the family when she was still a baby, she is a sibling among two boys who are currently not going to school because of no support. The mother washes clothes for people in the village in order to earn a living.

Steven is six years old is in primary one class at Zana community Christian school. He lives with both his parents. The father barely earns enough to support his family; he has two sisters. And the family cannot raise support for his family.



14. OUMO EPHRON

Ephron is a nine-year-old in primary three class at Zana community Christian School. He has 2 other siblings He lives with his mother and his two siblings; his father barely makes enough money to support the family.



15. KIWAWA JOSHUA

Joshua is a five-year-old in kindergarten in Zana community Christian , he lives with his father. The mother left them behind to go and farm on their little piece of land and which cannot fully support them as a family.

Trinity is a nine-year-old in primary three at Zana community Christian school, she has two siblings her father is a struggling dad who does odd jobs to earn a living to support the family

Ann is a six-year-old girl in kindergarten class at Zana Community Christian School; Ann lives away from her parents who are way back in the village and now lives with a well-wisher who cannot support her through school.

Ritah is ten years old in kindergarten at Zana Community Christian School. Her passed on and lives with her mother and her other nine siblings. The mother does farming on their little piece of land in order to get the food that the family survives on.

Crispus a sixteen-year-old in senior one class at Zana Christian High School. He lost all his parents when he was still a baby and lives with her poor grandmother who is sick and cannot work. Christine is a fifteen-year-old in senior one at Zana Christian High School. Her father passed on in fatal road accident. Christine lives with her mother who does different odd jobs to be able to earn a living to raise Christine and her other six siblings.



29. KIBIRA ALVIN

Alvin is a thirteen-year-old in primary five class at Zana community Christian School, both his parents passed on when he was still a baby. Alvin lives with a well wisher where he had been brought in to serve as a house help at the age ten years.

Blessing is a six-year-old girl in Kindergarten at Zana Community Christian School. She has one sibling who lives with the mother far away in the village who does farming at their small piece of land in order to get what to eat. She lives with her father who also work different odd jobs so as to be able to support his daughter.
